Aims and Objectives

A Brief History of Queensland Chinese Forum

Introduction & Incorporation

In the last forty years, the population of Chinese migrants and Chinese Australians settling in Queensland have increased substantially. During the same time, over a hundred community associations and organizations have been formed within different sectors of the Chinese community to look after the interests and welfare of their members. In spite of their varied objectives and activities, the majority of the Chinese community associations support the idea that there should be a body which can represent the Chinese community when important issues affecting the whole community arise and need to be addressed. Resources and energy can also be pooled and channelled effectively for activities and initiatives benefiting all members of the Chinese community.

The Council of Chinese Organisations of Queensland was first proposed in 1984 by several Chinese ethnic community leaders and an interim committee was set up as the preparatory group. The Council was renamed the Liaison Committee of Chinese Organisations of Queensland in 1987; and later as the Queensland Chinese Forum (the Forum, QCF) when it was formally constituted in 1994 with seven member associations (Cathay Community Association, Chinese Business and Professional Association Qld, Chinese Ethnic Broadcasting Association of Qld, Chinese Fraternity Association of Qld, Hong Kong Business & Professional Association of Qld, Qld Chinese Food and Beverage Hospitality Association, and Taiwan Friendship Association Qld).

QCF was incorporated in January 1995 to represent its members on general matters and issues which are of mutual concern to the Chinese community in Queensland, whilst individual member associations retain full autonomy in the management of their own activities and affairs. It is intended QCF to be the collective voice of all Chinese in Queensland.

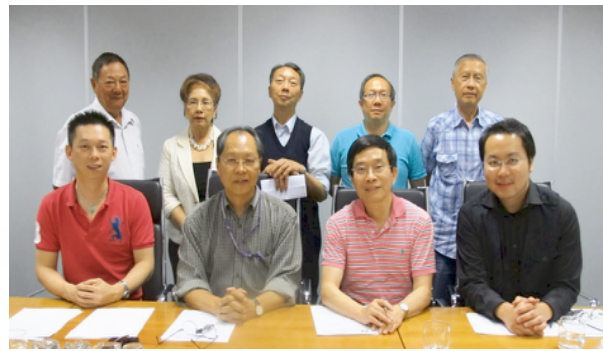

QCF, as the official peak organisation of the Queensland Chinese community, gathered on this occasion of the Chinese New Year, to celebrate the outstanding achievements and great contribution to the society by Chinese residents in Australia. 'look forward to what we, together with your Government be able to achieve in business as well as the welfare of the community as one, for this place we all call home'. Premier fights for lion's share of tax

Mr Newman yesterday fore-shadowed a "strong disagreement" with the Commonwealth. If the new federal mining tax does not deliver more money for roads and other vital projects.

Mr Newman's comments come ahead of his first Council of Australian Governments meeting in Canberra on Friday. The NSW and WA conservative governments have both raised royalty rates despite federal threats to strip them of GST income. Mr Newman said he would not oppose the tax on principle if the Gillard Government spent more on infrastructure in Queensland.

"As long as the Federal Government demonstrates that we will make no apologies for saving money right across the Government, because my team's top priority is to ease cost-of-living pressures for Queensland families," Premier Campbell Newman said.

However, Mr Newman said there would be "strong disagreement" if the infrastructure money failed to flow and fore-shadowed increased royalty rates.

Meanwhile, the Newman Cabinet met formally for the first time yesterday and focused on a cost-of-living promise made during the election.

Vehicle registration will be frozen and looming public transport fare increases halved from July 1.

The \$700 residential stamp duty discount, dumped in the final High government budget, will be reinstated.

However, the LNP's promise to freeze power prices has been complicated by the carbon tax. Mr Newman committed to save households about \$120 annually through a freeze on the common residential tariff.

However, the Premier said the state would not absorb the impact of the carbon tax, which would add about \$50 annually to household bills.

The Government is considering either cutting or freezing the tariff or introducing a more cost-effective pricing system proposed by the Queensland Competition Authority.

"The tariff will be as a minimum frozen, the carbon tax comes on top of that," Mr Newman said. "But the Prime Minister is saying the is providing compensation."

Mr Newman said the Government would legislate to have the cost of the carbon tax displayed on electricity bills.

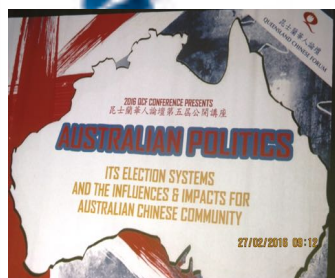

The Fifth QCF Conference – Australian Politics 昆士蘭華人論壇第五屆公開講座

Its election systems and the influences and impacts
for Australian Chinese Community.



2016年2月27日，由昆士蘭華人論壇主辦的第五屆公開講座在 MacGregor 州立小學的禮堂內舉行，講座以《澳洲政壇風雲：論其選舉制度及其對在澳華人群體的影響和沖擊》為主題。來自布里斯本當地的10餘名政要以及昆士蘭科技大學法學院副教授受邀共同出席了此次講座。昆士蘭華人論壇會長陳建勳 (Johnson Chen) 主持當日講座並致開幕詞，昆士蘭科技大學法學院副教授 Dr Mark Lauchs 主持全場專題討論會。

The Fourth QCF Conference 「昆士蘭華人論壇」第四屆公開講座

Optimising Trade & Investments between Asia and Australia

「昆士蘭華人論壇」於2014年10月11日舉辦第四屆公開講座－澳亞經貿合作促進研討會。研討會由會長陳建勳 (Johnson Chen) 及祕書長于惟祺 (Vicky Yu) 主持。華人商界領袖與政府商貿部代表就澳亞經貿事項進行交流，並針對自由貿易協議等相關政策展開討論。昆士蘭州投資貿易局 (Trade & Investment Queensland) 總裁 Andrew Tulloch 指出昆州經濟增長迅速，持續超過澳洲平均經濟增長和多個G20經濟體，是澳洲經濟發展最快的地區。來自中國的投資橫跨昆州各個行業，包括石油和天然氣、煤炭開採、房地產、農業和運輸等。另外，值得一提的是中國與澳大利亞的自由貿易協定正處於談判階段，將進一步開拓商機，增加貿易與投資。

布里斯本推廣局 (Brisbane Marketing) 招商總監 Steven Silvester 詳細分析了昆士蘭州以及作為澳洲新世界 (全球) 城市的布里斯本近幾年的經濟增長與預測，各項數值遠超過了澳洲平均值，使之成為未來15至20年澳洲經濟發展重點城市，包括布里斯本國際機場擴建、皇后港、公車火車地下通道、文化基地等政府基礎設施建設項目的落地。市長協會 (Council of Mayors SEQ) 行政總監 Peter Olah 代表包括布里斯本、黃金海岸、陽光海岸、洛根、圖文巴等12個市長介紹了占有澳洲1/7人口、20% GDP 的昆士蘭東南部將重點發展農業、旅遊業、教育培訓與醫療養老產業。Peter強調各級政府 (聯邦、州及地區) 將針對海外投資相關條例積極探討並適當放寬相關政策以促進地區經濟文化發展。

研討會亦特別提出了海外留學生在昆士蘭工作與創業的機會。聯邦議員 Dr Jim Chalmers MP 一直以來積極投入探討海外留學生相關條例，Jim 強調將持續鞭策政府，放寬留學生政策。Steven Silvester 介紹了布里斯本的「學生大使計劃」同時表示希望促進政府與學生間的交流與合作，完善未來計劃方針。



布里斯本市政府前議長 Kevin Bianchi 曾多次帶領政府、企業代表團前往中國考察，指出雙方經貿往來的重要性以及對今後發展的重大意義。Ray White Surfers Paradise Group 總裁 Andrew Bell 指出近期多個重量級亞洲富豪出現在黃金海岸並席捲耀眼投資項目。澳洲聯邦銀行、Morgans 投資銀行、Successful Wealth 貸款專家、TH Migration 移民等代表進而介紹政府相關政策的實施以及為各行各業所帶來的無限商機。與會者向主講嘉賓及議員、政府官員作出熱切提問，顯示華人社區對澳亞經貿及相關議題的濃厚興趣。

The Conference was hosted by President Johnson Chen and Secretary Vicky Yu on the day and was well represented by various levels and departments of federal, state and local governments and business leaders from a diverse industry sectors to discuss upcoming projects such as Brisbane Airport runway expansion, Queen's Wharf, Brisbane Metro, Cross River Railway projects that will place South East Queensland onto the world map over the next 15 to 20 years as the centre for business growth and development.

From those detailed presentations and in-depth discussions about governments priorities and forecasts, several market opportunities had been identified, notably those in the resources, property, agriculture, education and age care sectors have all been earmarked as growth areas. This has certainly boosted business confidence and resulted in several business enquiries for future collaborations.

昆州華人慶祝昆士蘭州建立一百五十周年



據文獻記載，華人最早於一百六十年前的1847年抵達昆士蘭，從事出賣勞動力的工作，例如放牧、剪羊毛、廚務、園丁、僕人等。其後由於昆州北部發現金礦，大量華工湧入昆士蘭，一度令華人在Palm River金礦場佔人口的百分之九十。在1881年華人佔當時昆州總人口百分之五點三，比現時的比例(低於百分之二)還多。

昆士蘭是在1859年十二月脫離新南威爾斯，成為澳洲一個新的殖民州 (colony)。今年昆士蘭各地都會大事慶祝昆州建立一百五十周年 (Q150)，活動詳情都刊登在州政府的Q150網址(www.q150.qld.gov.au)，而其中一項活動與昆州華人息息相關。

作為慶祝昆州建立一百五十周年 (Q150) 活動之一，『昆士蘭華人論壇』(Qld Chinese Forum) 與『昆士蘭華人博物館』(Chinese Museum of Qld) 於二〇〇九年十月二十四日下午在州議會大樓的 Premiers' and Speakers Halls 舉辦一個多媒體展覽及講座，主題是《華人在昆士蘭定居歷史》(Virtual Exhibition of the History of Chinese Settlement in Queensland)，出席的嘉賓約二百五十人，代表近二十個社團。

州長代表蔡偉民議員 (Michael Choi) 首先致辭，他以身為第一位華人出任昆州議員的個人經驗，講述華人在澳洲社會扮演角色的歷史變化，替大會拉開序幕。籌委會主席張奇博士繼而致歡迎辭，指出今次講座是「華人論壇」在二〇〇七年第一屆公開講座 (QCF Conference) 後的新一次突破性學術活動。

當日節目包括錄像播影及專題演講，回顧華人在昆州的長久歷史。錄像人物介紹是三位昆州知名華人：昆士蘭大學副校長遼高清教授 (Prof. Max Lu)、馳譽國際名畫家周綠雲女士 (Irene Chou) 及本地知名商人黃勇先生 (Peter Huang)。地標介紹則包括有一百二十多年歷史，位於布市 Breakfast Creek 的三聖宮、華人聚居的新利班 (Sunnybank) 及中天寺華文學校。

第一位演講嘉賓是昆州華人歷史學家 Kevin Wong Hoy。他從婚姻的角度講述華人早期在昆州北部定居的辛酸史。第二位演講嘉賓是前聯邦國參議員劉威廉 William O'Chee。他的祖先在一百三十年前移居澳洲，現在已是第五代。他從各年代的傑出華人實例表証華裔移民對昆州的重大貢獻。

「昆士蘭華人論壇」華裔軍人紀念鐘及第一屆公開講座 2007

Other significant QCF activities include the establishment of a commemorative bell in Chinatown Mall in 2007 and Australians of Chinese Heritage War Memorial in 2011, for those Chinese who fought for Australia during the World Wars, and Music in Harmony concerts in 2008 and 2011.

To recognise the contribution of Australian Service personnel of Chinese heritage in Australia's past armed conflicts, QCF commenced a project of establishing a commemorative memorial for Chinese who had fought for Australia during the World Wars. In July 2004 the Cathay Community Association, a member of QCF, with the support of the QCF and NGVR submitted to the Commonwealth Department of Veterans' Affairs for a Community War Memorial grant under the 'Saluting Their Service' Grants. The Brisbane City Council also committed to pay for the installation of a Bell, as well as its ongoing maintenance. QCF subsequently commissioned a foundry in China to cast a commemorative bronze bell. The official launch of the Commemorative Bell on Saturday 10 March 2007 was organized by QCF in cooperation with the Brisbane City Council and Australian Defence Forces. The Bell plaque was unveiled by the then Lord Mayor Campbell Newman in the presence of senior representatives of the Australian Defence Forces.

當日講座有一百三十多人參加，由州議會代議長 Acting Speaker John English 為講座揭幕。「昆士蘭華人論壇」會長張奇發言講述主辦講座意義，及向與會人士介紹「論壇」幹事及各成員團體會長或代表。理事 Phillip Chan 隨即啟動「昆士蘭華人論壇」互聯網網頁。

陽光海岸大學高級講師 Scott Prasser 及選舉局局長 David Kerslake 講解了澳洲政制及選舉制度沿革，為講座拉開帷幕。繼下來的三位講者 Milton Dick、Dr Bruce Flegg 及 Rosemary Menkens 分別介紹他們所屬的工黨、自由黨和國家黨。

下午的講座集中於華人參政的現況和展望。屬於工黨的 Linda Holliday 講述了競選成功之道，現任昆州議員蔡偉民及聯邦議員 Michael Johnson 現身說法，談及他們個人從政經驗（兩位議員都曾經出任「昆士蘭華人論壇」幹事），而有意從政的兩位華裔青年 William Tan（自由黨）與 Chiu Hing Chan（工黨）則講述他們的理想和抱負。最後「論壇」秘書李昂（Ang Li）為整個講座作了精湛總結。難得的是講座完畢前，與會者向各講者作出了熱切提問，顯示華人社區對澳洲政治的濃厚興趣。

The first QCF Conference entitled "Australian Chinese, Australian Politics" was held on Sunday 11 March 2007 at the Undumbi Room of Parliament House, Brisbane. It was opened by the Acting Speaker of Parliament John English MP and attended by about 140 people, including eleven keynote speakers including David Kerslake (Electoral Commissioner), Dr Scott Prasser (University of Sunshine Coast), Milton Dick (ALP), Dr Bruce Flegg, MP, Rosemary Menkens MP, Linda Holliday (ALP), Michael Johnson MP, Michael Choi MP, Willain Tan (Liberal Party), Chiu Hing Chan (ALP) and Ang Li (QCF). Apart from speeches and open forum, there was also a mini concert with performance by six musicians of very high calibre.

The conference aimed to raise awareness and interest on politics and political system among Australian Chinese in Queensland with two objectives: presenting views on the past, present and future of involvement of Queensland Chinese in politics; providing insight into political systems in Australia.

Chinese War Memorial

In order to raise awareness in the Chinese community and the wider Australian community in Queensland of the contribution of Australian Service personnel of Chinese heritage in Australia's past armed conflicts, the Queensland Chinese Forum with the support of the Cathay Community Association and the New Guinea Volunteer Rifles and Papua New Guinea Volunteer Rifles ex Members Association, and funding from the Federal Government, State Government and Brisbane City Council, installed a Commemorative Bell in the Fortitude Valley Chinatown in 2007.

On 19 May 2009, the Federal Member for Moreton Graham Perrett proposed a southside memorial to Australian Defence Force personnel of Chinese descent. A Steering Committee was formed to plan for the proposed War Memorial. Members of this committee include Graham Perrett MP, Robert Lippiatt - President of Sunnybank RSL, Tom Seeto, Ralph Seeto and Rank Tsui of the Cathay Community Association, Peter Low OAM of Queensland Chinese Forum, David Forde of Lions Club of Kuraby, Lewis Lee of Lions Club of Brisbane Chinese, Kee Cheung and Ray Poon of the Chinese Museum of Queensland, as well as other members from the Chinese community. In October 2009, the then Hon Alan Griffin, Minister for Veterans' Affairs & Defence Personnel, launched the War Memorial design competition and a judging panel of five (Robert Lippiatt, Lewis Lee, Douglas Ng, Rank Tsui and Kee Cheung) was commissioned by the Chinese War Memorial Steering Committee to choose the winning design. The memorial was later established in the Veterans Memorial Garden of the Returned and Services League of Australia at Gager Street, Sunnybank, and dedicated on Sunday 17 April 2011.

Music in Harmony

Aiming to promote multicultural harmony, QCF organised two 'Music in Harmony' concerts; one in Chinatown Mall on 22 November 2008 and another at Roma Street Parklands Amphitheatre on 5 November 2011. Performers involved artists from indigenous community, Chinese community, African community, Brazilian community etc.

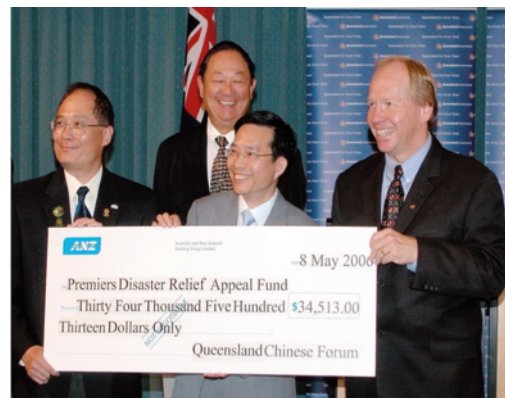

Submissions / Responses

QCF also regularly responds to political situations and government policies. In late 1996, in response to mounting public debate on multiculturalism and racial discrimination after the election of Pauline Hanson to the Federal Parliament, the Forum established a special Task Force to work out long term strategies for promoting racial harmony and social cohesion in Queensland and Australia.

In November 1996, QCF and the Vietnamese community in Queensland co-hosted a dinner seminar to denounce the racist views of Pauline Hanson. QCF then participated in a protest march in Ipswich to voice our concerns. In 2013, the government proposed to change the Racial Discrimination Act, Section 18 C in particular. QCF collectively provided a response objecting to such changes.

QCF represents its members on general matters and issues which are of mutual concern to the Chinese community in Queensland. QCF will continue to advance the interests of ethnic Chinese people and promotion of multiculturalism in Queensland Australia in the years to come.

南區安全座談會

5月12日，由南區華人社區安全諮詢委員會在 Mosley 街 566 號 舉行，此次座談會由主席黃志強 (BSCC) 秘書黃志強主持。華人新區 (QCF) 副會長黃志強，南區社區委員會 (BSCC) 主席王學明和華人社區防止罪案諮詢委員會 (CCCPC) 主席于維祺聯合主持座談會。

南區治安問題突出，影響各階層市民正常生活。座談會與華人及警方提供了一次與警方高層代表面對面討論治安問題的機會，和共同尋求解決方法。

西北角地產公司 (NCAO) 會長石君代表「南區安全行動」小組發言，報告該區治安問題。該區委員會代表來自 Sunrybank 及附近社區 157 名治安問題諮詢。

一位受害者描述被劫匪分子的暴力襲擊，因為劫匪分子沒有受到嚴厲的懲罰，並且很快被釋放出來，本來是治安問題的地方，但現在在案發地感覺到恐懼。

一位受害者說他的家至少都曾被入侵一次，而對一些在案發地居住之區，一些警務處居住的地方從來不會有編制上級的。「安全是區區是關鍵」性區區是關鍵。

華人社區應以此不在於提出以下建議：

- 針對南區入案諮詢，警方成立特別行動小組，整地北區治安
- 增加警務處在區區治安力量
- 區區 Sunrybank 警務處時間
- 在案發地治安諮詢中心增設治安巡邏警務
- 建立南區社區入到「嚴守守區」機制，利用區區治安巡邏一機
- 針對多元社區提供 Police 111 的

諮詢版本
由維祺秘書 Brian Wilkins 指出許多犯罪分子是機會主義者，居民們應提高自身和國家安全警備性，讓士警務處有安全警備警務和國家安全檢查表提供給廣大社區民衆，以協助的動態。

警務處和警察白蘭斯，提供針對劫匪分子的訓練手段，例如 Operation Assurance, Operation Mable, Operation Loco, 針對劫匪點點對點和「和警方自行車機動巡邏等，已經取得初步成效，約降低了犯罪機會。同時也應中區民防治安防範警務手段。

此外，警方即將展開一次為期 28 天的針對高層的安全警備行動，動用制製警務和便法警務，用多種方法打擊犯罪，並及時評估，調整以後的行動。

當天與會均有社區華人社團代表、受害者群體代表、議會現任議員、而政府議員、警方代表，並由南區士蘭州議會前議員黃偉民先生主持。

Aims & Objectives

To address all matters pertaining to crime prevention in the Chinese community of Queensland, by providing an opportunity for police and Chinese-speaking community members to address issues of concern in a collaborative way.

The objective is to set up a mechanism so that community members have a facility to discuss issues of concern.

The role of the Chinese Community Crime Prevention Consultative Committee is to:

- Develop crime prevention and other proactive strategies in the Chinese community
- Distribute important government law and order information to the community
- Report and follow up significant crime incidents
- Provide support to vulnerable groups eg new arrivals and students
- Provide referral services and facilitate cooperation with other government agencies
- Address crime related issues eg gambling
- Promote strategies and achievements to the broader community

Incorporated in 1996 by the International City Church to meet the needs of Brisbane’s culturally and linguistically diverse (CALD) community, Multicultural Community Centre (MCC) offers a wide range of services. From organising cultural festivals to training CALD migrants and refugees in Australian accredited courses so that they gain good employment with career pathways, MCC has garnered distinguished awards for its efforts.

- In 2016, MCC was awarded the first **Queensland Minister’s Multicultural Award** by the Department of Multicultural Affairs (chosen among 27 state finalists).
- In 2018, MCC was the Winner (Metropolitan Region) as well as State Finalist of the **Queensland Training Awards** for Community Training Initiative of the Year.

With the **Skilling Queenslanders for Work (SQW)** funding awarded by the Queensland government since 2015, MCC has and continues to help hundreds of new migrants and refugees to obtain accredited qualifications to secure jobs, and start a new life in Australia.

MCC’s current **Certificate III in Early Childhood Education** and **Certificate III in Individual Support (Disability, Ageing)** regularly achieve 100% completion rate for course participants. This is due to the extra language support and coaching by MCC’s training partner, the Asian Pacific Institute. With additional services such as **Job Preparation Workshops** and **Industry Placements**, more than 75% of MCC’s graduate find employment and this is a consistent achievement in every MCC SQW project.

Agedcare Course Workshop



In MCC's SQW Work Skills Traineeship projects, participants are trained in the Certificate I in Business and organise the Annual Technicolour Multicultural Festival, Christmas Show and Markets and Chinese New Year Night Markets at Diverciti Centre. These festivals draw huge crowds who enjoy the delicious cuisine, cultural shows, workshops and kids' activities.

MCC's Settlement Engagement and Transition Support program funded by the Department of Home Affairs help migrants, refugees and humanitarian entrants to integrate with the wider community during their settlement journey. Information sessions on life-skills topics such as tenancy issues, Centrelink payments, health issues, nutrition, domestic violence, job search, basic computer skills, banking, home loans, QLD Police services etc are held regularly. Through these information sessions, MCC has been able to provide the participants an opportunity to establish their lives in Australia.

MCC also runs 'Developing and Growing Small Business' short courses for those seeking to set up their own businesses. Participants include those who already have a small business but are facing many problems; as well as those who want to do business, but lack the necessary 'know-how' to do so. Experienced entrepreneurs run workshops, and act as coaches and mentors.

多元文化社区中心 (MCC) 由国际城市教会于1996年成立, 以协助布里斯班多元文化文化背景居民和社区的移民落户需求, 从组织各种文化节的带薪工作技能培训到在澳洲认可的课程培训, 使其在澳洲职业道路上获得良好就业机会。MCC的努力和付出因而赢得了几项昆州杰出奖项。

- 2016 Queensland Minister's Multicultural Award 昆州部长多元文化杰出奖
- 2018 Queensland Training Awards 昆州培训杰出奖 (都市区)

MCC的三级幼儿教育证书和三级个人支持 (残疾/老龄化) 证书, 近几年的学生学业完成率都达到100%。这是由于MCC的培训合作伙伴亚太学院 (API) 提供了额外的语言支持。同时MCC也会安排各种增加找到工作的机会的讲座等其他服务, 每个MCC SQW项目都有超过75%的毕业生在完成课程后都找到了工作。

MCC的SQW带薪工作技能培训项目, 为“一级商务证书”包括组织一年一度的Technicolour多元文化节, 或者圣诞市集活动和话剧表演以及农历新年夜市和文化表演。这些节日每次都吸引近两千群众, 享受不同文化的美食, 文化表演, 工作坊和儿童活动。

由联邦政府内政部资助的MCC的“新移民落户服务”项目可帮助新移民, 难民和人道主义人员在定居过程中与更广泛的社区融合并定期举行有关生活技能主题的信息讲座会, 例如租赁问题, Centrelink 付款, 健康问题, 营养, 家庭暴力, 求职, 基本计算机技能, 银行业务, 住房贷款, 昆士兰州警察服务等。通过这些信息讲座会, MCC能够为参与者提供在澳洲落户建立生活的帮助机会。

MCC还为寻求建立小型企业的人开设了“发展和成长小型企业”短期课程。参加者包括那些已经有小生意但面临许多问题的人, 以及那些想做生意但缺乏必要的“诀窍”的人。

The Queensland Zhejiang Association of Australia was established in June 2016 and registered with the Australian government under the name of "Queensland Zhejiang United Association Incorporated". The association is a voluntary non-profit social organization of Zhejiang people from Queensland, Australia. The association comprises the Queensland Zhejiang Association of Fellow Provincials and the Queensland Zhejiang Chamber of Commerce.



In November 2016, we have held our grand opening ceremony to announce the establishment of the association. Since then, it has gone through three fantastic years. The association is continuously carrying out its function which is through various channels such as websites, publications, lectures, seminars, etc., we exchange experiences, share resources and provide consulting services for members to live and develop business in Australia.



The association has also held many special activities with various characteristics in past three years, such as the Brisbane Chinese Festival Parade, Christmas party, Dragon Boat Festival party, Double Ninth Festival Hiking, Badminton Friendship Tournaments and so on. All the members who are far away from home have reunion here and become a big warm family.



Under the effort of committee and members, the association has grown from the beginning to the continuous development. It has been recognized and awarded the multicultural award by members of the Queensland Government for many times. All the association members have built up the emotional bond and a foundation of trust. Looking forward to the future, the association will take off on the basis laid down in the previous three years and make greater contributions to all members and community.





Chinese Ethnic Broadcasting Association of Qld

Radio 4EB commenced broadcasting in December 1979. The Chinese community was invited to join the 4EB family in 1980. In the September 1980 issue of The Ethnic Voice, it was mentioned that “There are now 36 programming groups broadcasting on 4EB, 11 of these groups having joined 4EB since the opening of the station last December”. The Newsletter listed the 36 language groups including the Chinese Group which was allocated two time slots: 11.00 - 11.30 and 11.30 -12.00 Sunday. The address of Radio 4EB at that time was 249 Montague Road, West End.

Professor Leung Sun (Ming) Leung was the Founding Chairperson (Convener) of the Chinese Group which manages the Cantonese and Mandarin programs.

In 1985 4EB was given the current block of land at Kangaroo Point where the new studio was established. The Chinese Group has always been actively involved in the annual Radiothon which was originally initiated to fund raise for the new building.

Over the years our membership grew and our broadcasting time increased. Currently there is a very healthy proportion of youth programs produced by the Chinese Group.

Two of our members, Mr Wayne Lee (who served with Prof. Ming Leung in the early days and passed away recently) and Dr Peter Ho AM are Life Members of the Radio. Many of our members have been awarded certificates in appreciation of their consistent involvement in program production and broadcasting. Several members had served or are serving as Directors of 4EBFM. Peter Ho became the President of 4EBFM in 2000.

The Chinese Group does not have an ageing problem, which is fortunate, but faces the challenge of producing relevant programs to serve the local community which is also served by more and easily accessible alternative media such as newspapers and television channels in the Chinese language. “The Next Program is in the Cantonese/Mandarin Language” on FM98.1 cannot be taken for granted.

Cathay Community Association's office has been in Fortitude Valley since we incorporated in 1981. However due to parking and fire issues we decided to move to the south side. We purchased an industrial building at Coopers Plains which we were able to renovate to suit our own requirements. In January 2014, we opened for business at 71 Annie St from this new address.

Our main work is running the Commonwealth Home Support Program for the benefit of the community. In 2019 we passed a big milestone when we accepted our 500th client. On Wednesday, Thursday & Friday we bring clients to our Centre where we provide social activities and information on the latest changes to the program and how it will affect them. They can exercise following the instructor on the big screen, so it is fun as well as beneficial. This is followed by a home cooked meal provided by our own cooks. After lunch they can mingle and talk with their friends. Quite often the Case Managers come down and discuss with their clients any particular concerns. Those clients living on the northside can attend at the Aspley Bowls Club.

In order to attract Volunteers and Members we organise many other activities including Bus Tours, Golf Days, Taichi and our own Scout Group. In house we have we have Mahjong, Chinese Lessons, Computer Classes, Knitting and a Garden Group.

We are involved with the Chinese Victims of Crime Support Group (CVCSG). Also Chinese Community Crime Prevention Consultative Committee (CCCPC). Both these groups assist the community where they have been impacted by crime. We work closely with the Queensland Police Service particularly where translation is required.

凡65歲的長者，身體或體能有需要協助而讓其繼續在家裏居住的均可提出申請家居護理服務，宗親會的家庭護理主任可以代為申請及跟進。所有服務費用由政府提供的津貼中扣除，每月會有一份詳細的月結單，讓服務使用者及家人一目瞭然，清晰瞭解。

所有護理員工均接受專業訓練，並持有效證書，確保他們能提供最適切和貼心的服務。合資格的長者經評估和溝通後會訂定護理計劃，提供適合的服務，並作定期檢討跟進。服務項目包括家務助理、社交支援、衛生護理、註冊護士的專業評估和護理、交通協助、整理花園及其他專業護理。無論是協會的會長、委員、家庭護理主任都以愛心、同理心提供專業的服務。我們亦會根據長者的身體狀況，安排半天的戶外活動，讓其結識其他長者，彼此支持，並提升其生活質素，效果也非常顯著。

我們也為65歲以上，無論是否合乎家庭護理服務的長者提供日間中心活動，讓他們走出家園，接觸其他同齡人士，與社區保持聯繫，開拓新生活、脫離孤單和寂寞。日間中心受政府資助，每星期兩天以低廉的收費提供各種活動，包括早、午餐、早操、謎語、唱歌、遊戲、麻雀、專題講座、按摩、生日聚餐和旅行等，讓長者在退休後或晚年時能繼續享受高質素的生活。

(ZSS-Qld) was formally registered and established with its inaugural president Mr. Dennis Fung 馮國顯, Secretary General Professor Jack Ng 吳澤銘, Vice Presidents Mr. Ringo Wu 胡瑞光 and Mr. Tomas Yuen 阮國樞, Treasurers Mrs. Jan Wu 胡鍾燕燕 and Mrs. Anita Fung 馮吳玉瓊, committee members Mr. Joe Leong 梁佐昆 (deceased), Mr. Bobby Leung 梁清浦, Mr. Kwok Shu (Ian) Cheung 張國樹, Mrs. Wai Chun Cheung 張梁惠珍, Mrs. and Susan Hon Fay 馮德芳.

ZSS-Qld has been always a great supporter of the Biennial Zhongshan World Congress since 2004. A large delegation of members and friends attended the Congress in Macau, Canada, and Malaysia. These events provide great opportunities for linking up with our countrymen and their allied members from all over the world and have left us with many fond memories.

To their credit, the Gold Coast team won the inaugural Ping-Pong challenge by a narrow margin.

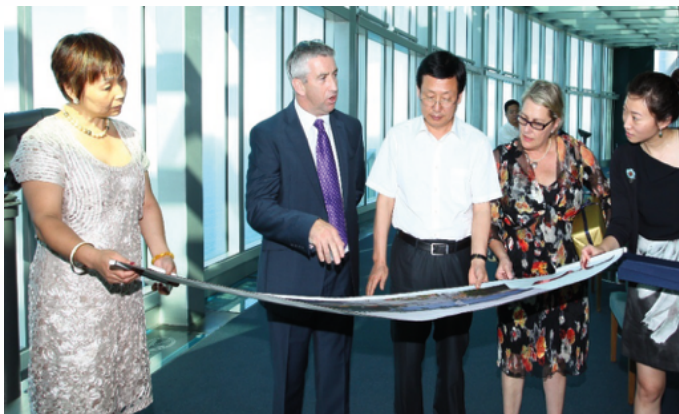

A Steering Committee to establish a Chinese Museum in Queensland was formed in October 2003. The chairperson of the Steering Committee was Mr. Peter Low OAM, and Vice Chairperson was Ms J eannie Mok. The project has the support of the Brisbane City Council.

The association Chinese Museum of Queensland (CMoQ), Inc was formally incorporated on 26 November 2004.

The objectives of CMoQ are:

1. To operate a museum promoting an appreciation of Chinese artifacts and culture, and the role and contributions of the Chinese in Queensland in particular and Australia in general.
2. To develop partnerships with other museums and historical and heritage organizations.
3. To foster an understanding and appreciation of the history of the Chinese in Queensland in particular and Australia in general.
4. To do all such things as are conducive or incidental to the aims and objects of the Chinese Museum.



CMoQ website launch 2011

Since its establishment, CMoQ executives has been actively looking for a suitable premises, with little success to date. Before a permanent home for the Museum can be found, correspondence to the CMoQ is via P.O. Box 8207, Sunnybank 4109.

In 2006, a Brisbane City Council (BCC) grant was awarded to CMoQ as a seeding support to conduct community awareness programs for the long term viability of the Museum.

In October 2009, CMoQ co-hosted a conference with the QCF in the Premiers' & Speakers' Halls, Parliament House Annex, Brisbane to commemorate 160 year of Chinese settlement in Qld and 150 year of the State of Qld. It was supported by the Q150 Community Funding Program, with the resulting production of a 6-part video documentary. A lot of material produced in the project can be used as part of the collections for the Museum.

With the current financial situation, there is little success of obtaining the government, whether local, state or federal to provide funding for the construction of a permanent museum premise. The prospect of getting major commercial sponsorship is also slim. A "virtual" Chinese Museum is the more viable option.

The Virtual Chinese Museum program includes the following components:

1. The development of a permanent and professional website for the Chinese Museum of Qld.
2. Public relations and marketing campaign for CMoQ.
3. The development and collection of historical articles and artifacts for the virtual museum.

From late 2013 CMoQ worked with the University of the Sunshine Coast to obtain more historical material on Chinese settlement in Queensland from late 2013. These information still have to be uploaded onto our website.

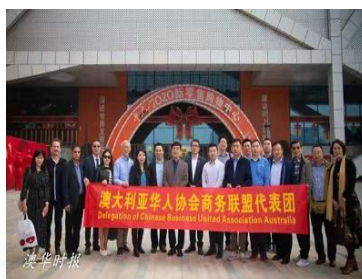
